



Advantages of Getting Your Instrument Rating

After earning your private pilot license, to fully utilize what personal air travel can accomplish, an Instrument Rating is essential. Instrument rating is often a pre-cursor to higher ratings and teaches you to fly the airplane precisely to tighter tolerances.

Estimated Costs of Instrument Rating

The typical cost of an Instrument Rating can be approximately \$11,729.00 excluding medical exam and required FAA testing. This includes 50 hours of Aircraft Rental for the required Cross Country times.
